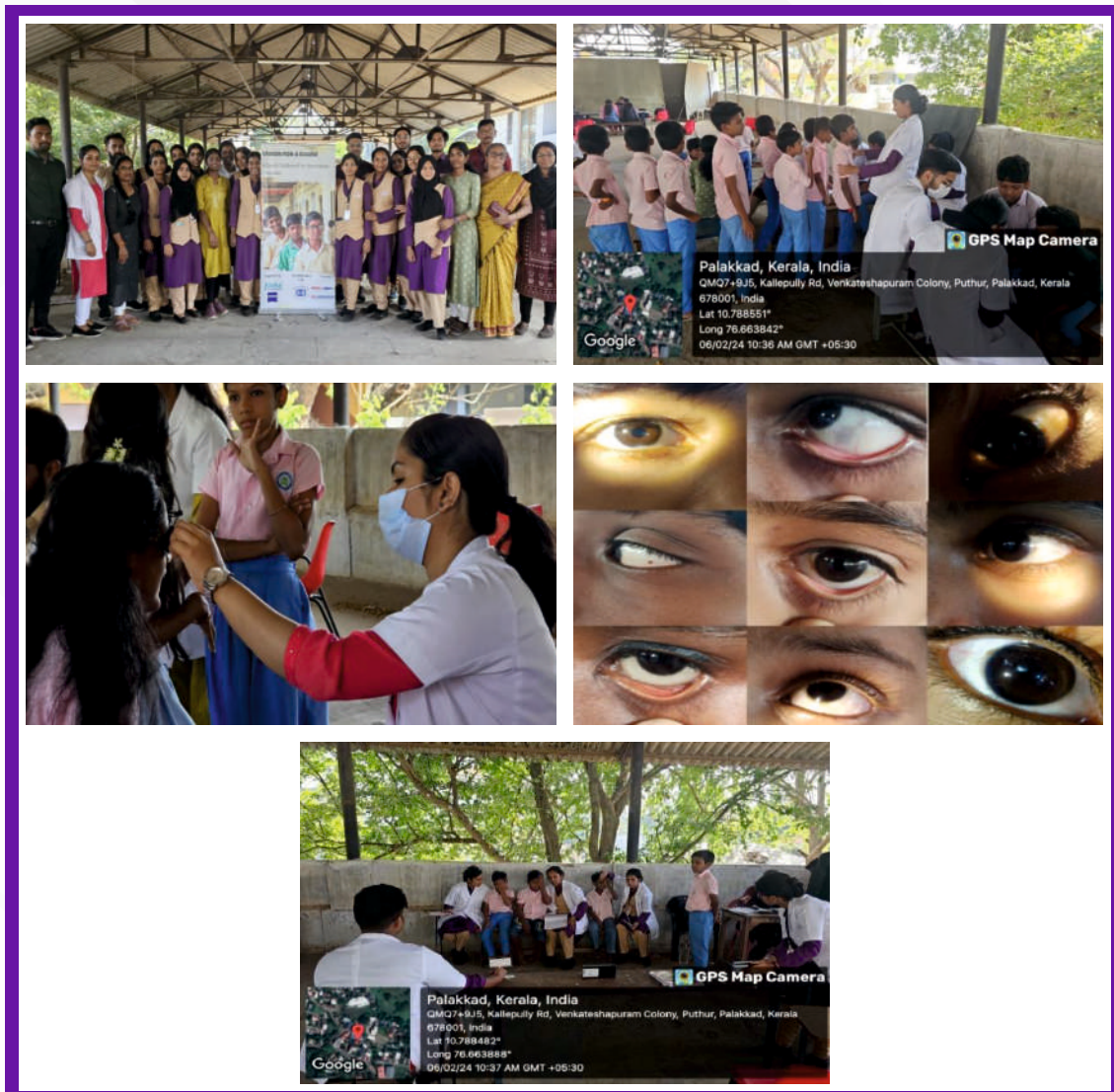

EYE CAMP AT GOVERNMENT UPPER PRIMARY SCHOOL, PUTHUR, PALAKKAD

Ahalia School of Optometry and Research Center has conducted an eye camp at Government Upper Primary School, Puthur, Palakkad on 05.02.2024 & 06.02.2024. Where we have done a detailed eye examination and Aloka Vision Programme provided a free spectacle for those who had uncorrected refractive errors. There were about 598 beneficiaries were screened and the students who were diagnosed with ocular disease and higher powers were referred to the nearest Aloka Referral centers for further detailed eye examination and treatment. 27 beneficiaries were prescribed spectacles and orders were placed.

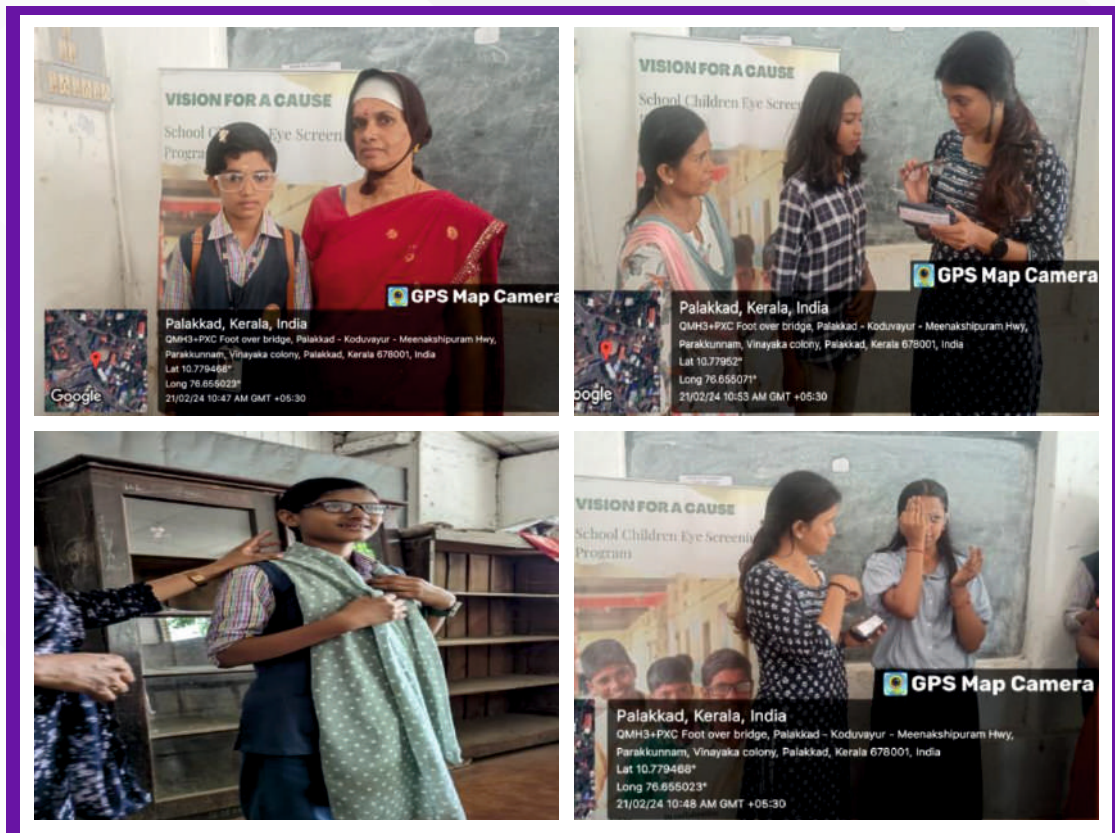

VISION FOR CAUSE PROGRAMME SPECTACLE DELIVERY @ GOVERNMENT U P SCHOOL, PUTHUR



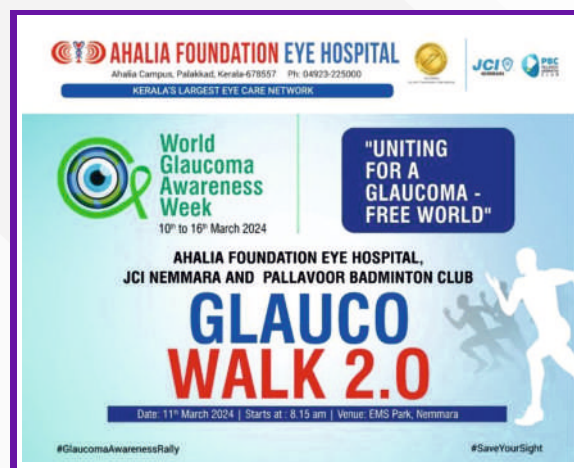

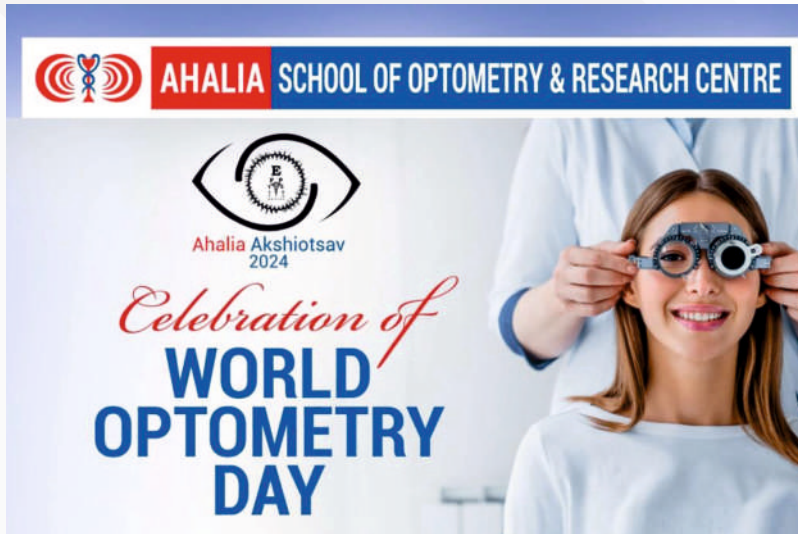
GLAUCO WALK 2.0

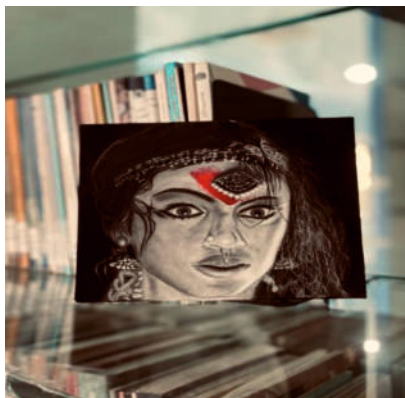
