77th REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

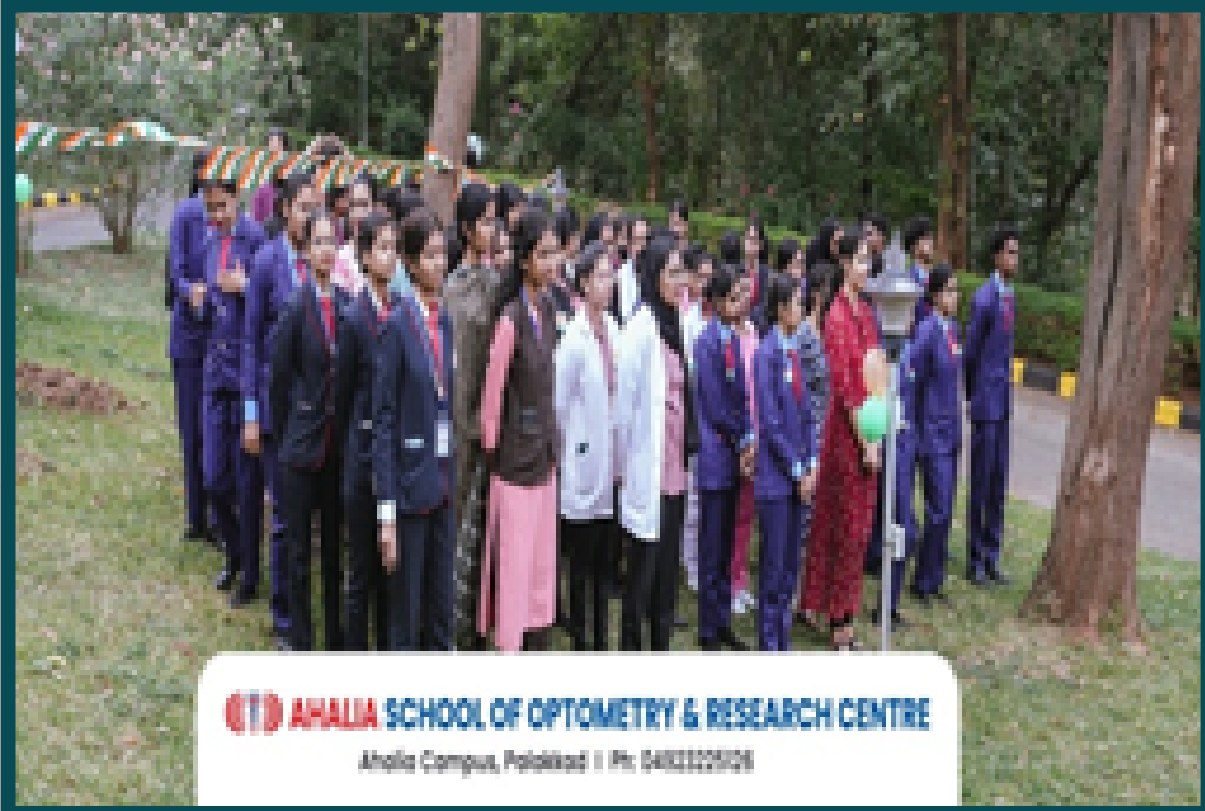

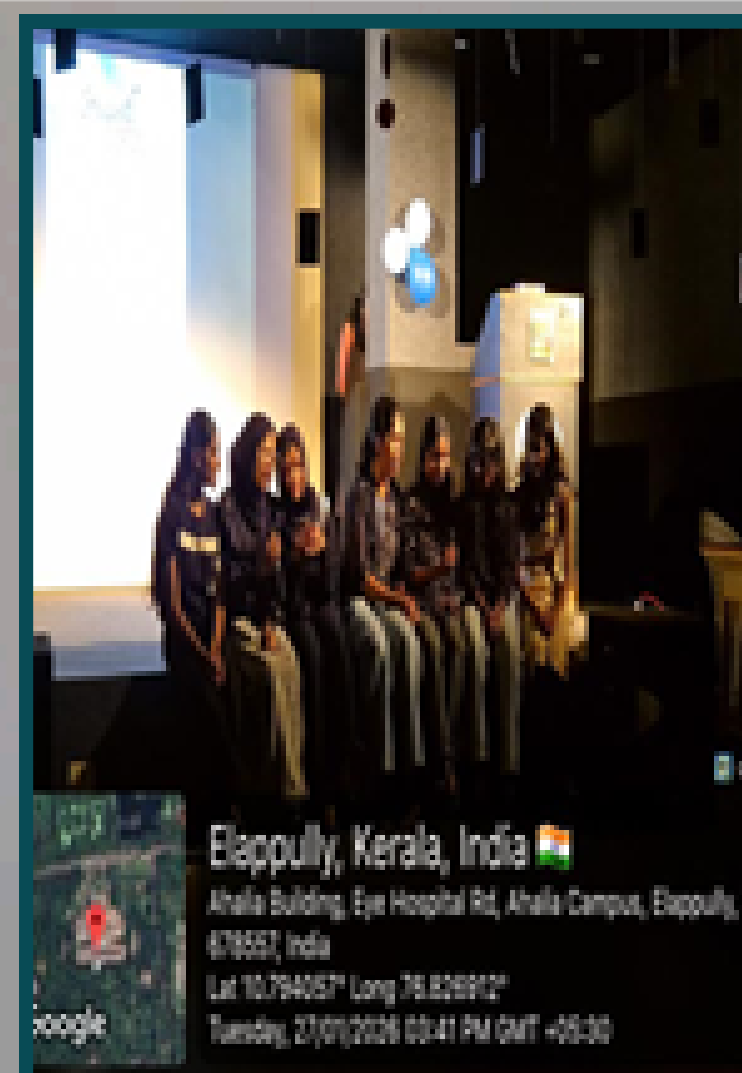


FAREWELL PROGRAMME

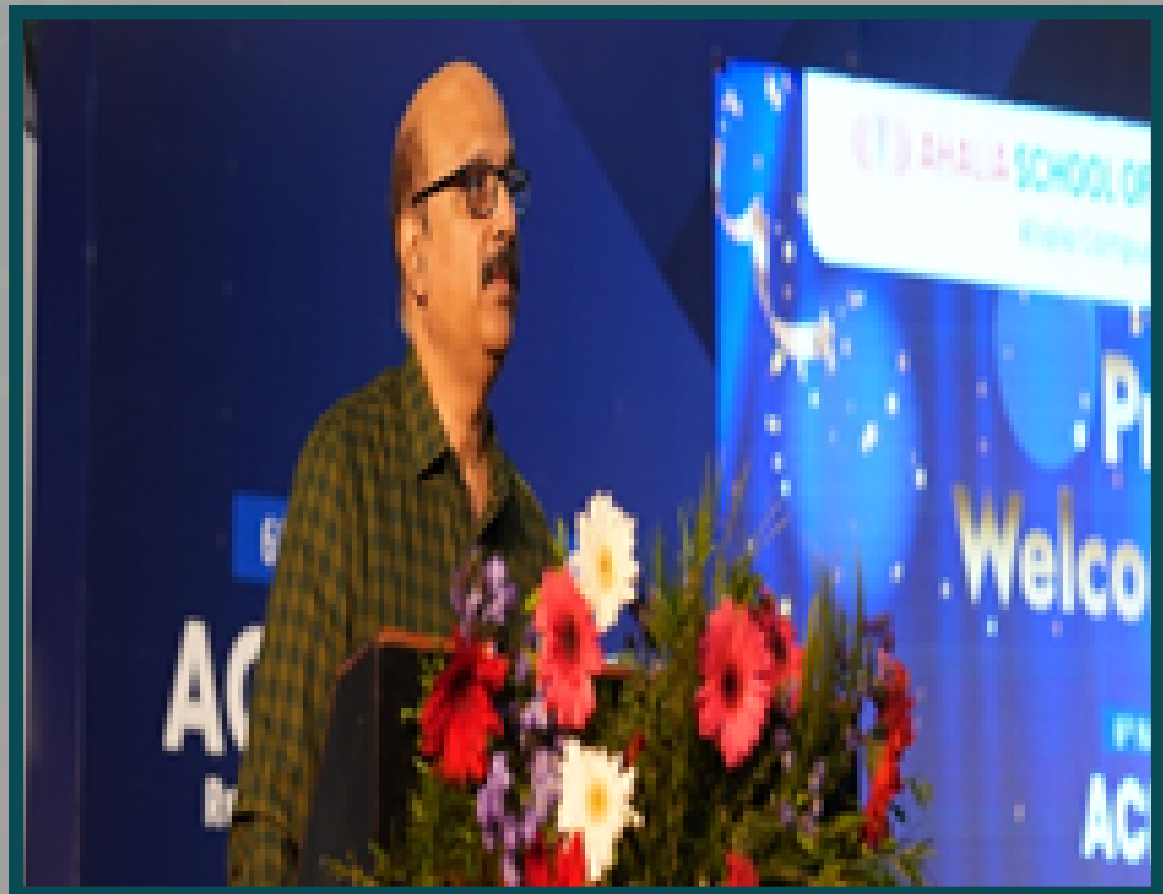
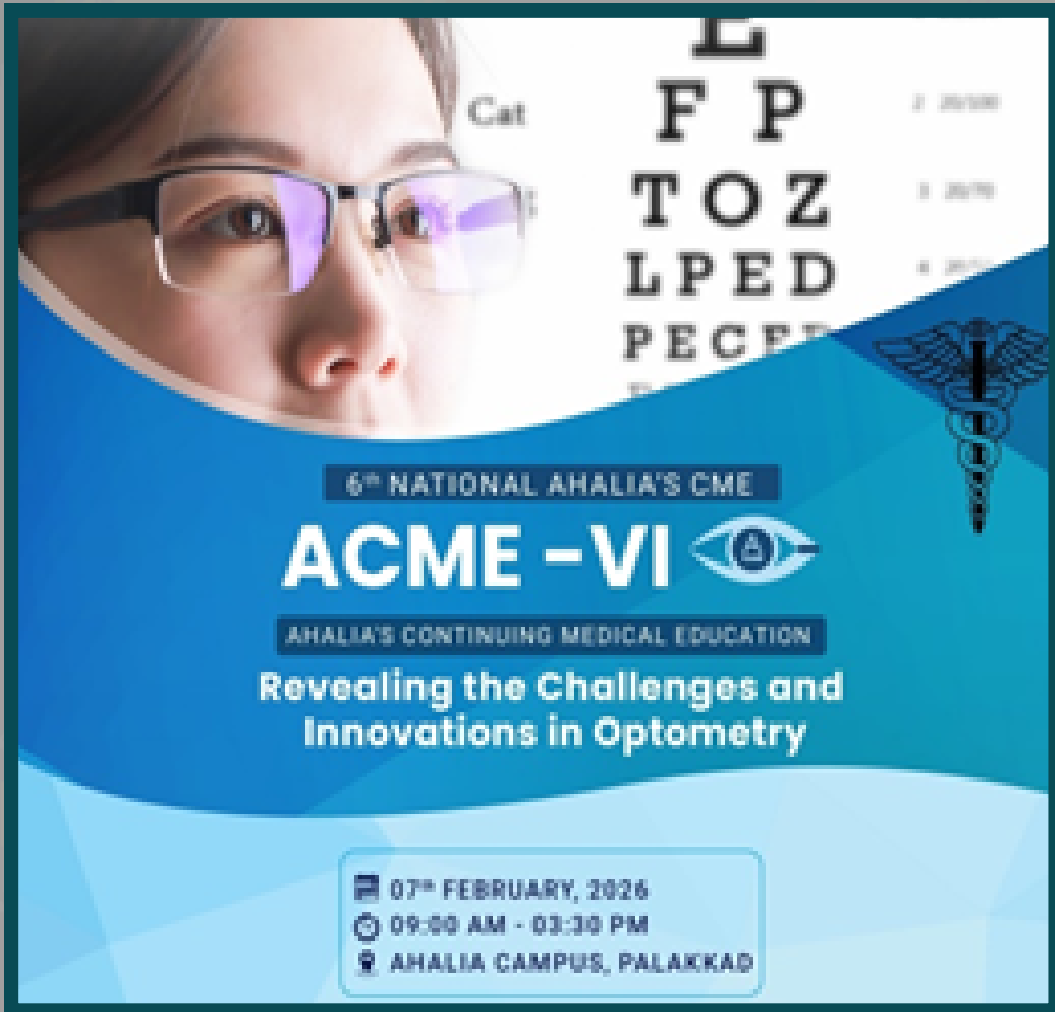
